Take part in a walking fundraising challenge with a difference for the Commonwealth War Graves Foundation

What is the virtual challenge?

Between 25 April and 27 May 2022, follow our virtual 95.2km route on an interactive journey through Normandy.

Starting at Ranville War Cemetery in France, cover the distance along the battlefields and CWGC cemeteries and memorials, including Bény-sur-Mer Canadian War Cemetery and Bayeux War Cemetery, and finishing at Bretteville-sur-Laize Canadian War Cemetery.

Cover the distance in any way you like - cycle, swim, walk, run, or jog, and take part from anywhere in the world.

Create a team with your family and friends or track your journey as an individual on your early morning dog walk, whilst out and about at the weekend, or on your daily run.

The entry fee for individuals and teams is £25 and your support will help raise awareness of the Commonwealth War Graves Foundation.

Challenge yourself to raise £100 for the CWGF, or as much as you can, and help us keep the stories alive of those men and women who died whilst fighting in the two World Wars.



How does it work?


Register for the challenge either as an individual or create a team. You can register by clicking the link on our website.

You can create and name a team when you sign up. Once you have done this, you can invite others to join your team using their email address. They will receive a link to register and join your team.

Once you have registered, your personal fundraising page will automatically be created. You can personalise your page with the details of the challenge, why you are supporting the CWGF, and you can set a fundraising target. You can share your personal fundraising page on social media and with friends and family to encourage them to follow along with your progress on your personal interactive map.

You can cover the distance in any way you like - walking, running or swimming. The fundraising pages use the mobile app Strava to automatically log your progress on your interactive map.

Alternatively, you can upload your progress manually. Details of how to do this can be found on the event page of our website.
